Completed Application: The application may be placed in a paper folder and the completed folder should include the application, transcripts, and test scores. The application can be typed or neatly printed in blue or black ink. The application may also be submitted via email. Please scan transcripts and test scores and email along with application to stgeorgegearizona@gmail.com.

Transcripts & SAT/ACT Scores: Include a current high school transcript of student grades. The transcript must include senior year classes. The SAT and/or ACT test scores must be included in the application but may be photocopies or printed from the SAT and/or ACT websites.

Additional Information: Any additional information that does not fit on the application form can be placed on a separate paper and attached to the end of the application form.

Awards: Multiple applicants will receive the scholarship awards. Winners will be notified by email.
